Bina Puri bags RM20.4m deal for Dengkil housing project

Company's orderbook now stands at RM2.7b with its latest project, says MD Tee

BINA Puri Holdings Bhd's wholly-owned subsidiary, Bina Puri Construction Sdn Bhd, has been awarded a project by

Jabatan Perumahan Negara worth RM20.4 million.

In an announcement to Bursa Malaysia yesterday, the construction player said the project, for the construction works of a housing project in Dengkil known as Taman Topaz, will commence this month and is expected to be completed in 14 months.

Bina Puri group managing director Tan Sri Tee Hock Seng

said the company's outstanding orderbook now stands at RM2.73 billion after taking into account the latest project.

"This year, we have secured new projects worth over RM1 billion, which is consistent with our performance over the last few years," he said in a statement.

An exchange filing yesterday said Bina Puri had managed to secure new projects worth up to about RM989.41 million year-

to-date. "The contract is expected to contribute positively to the earnings of Bina Puri Group for the financial year ending Dec 31, 2012," it said.

Tee said moving forward, the company is optimistic that the construction sector will benefit from the new allocations recently announced under Budget 2012 coupled with the spillover effects from the Economic Transformation Programme.
