# Bina Puri terima projek tambahan di Sabah

**B**INA Puri Holdings (Bina Puri) menerusi anak syarikat milik penuhnya, Bina Puri Sdn. Bhd. menerima surat tawaran kerja daripada Jabatan Kerja Raya Sabah bagi menjalankan kerja-kerja tambahan untuk pembinaan Kompleks Pentadbiran Kerajaan Negeri Sabah, Teluk Likas (fasa satu, kerja-kerja bangunan) bernilai RM64.99 juta.

Tawaran kerja itu menjadikan nilai tempahan yang belum dibina Bina Puri sebanyak RM2.01 bilion sehingga kini.

Pengarah Urusan Kumpulan, Tan Sri Datuk Tee Hock Seng berkata, surat tawaran itu diterima pihaknya pada 15 Disember lalu di bawah dana kemudahan Kerajaan Persekutuan.

Katanya, kerja-kerja tambahan itu termasuk menaik taraf kerja-kerja tembok laut sedia ada, menaik taraf bulatan luaran untuk cadangan lencongan trafik dan menaik taraf kerja untuk membuat pagar.

Jelasnya, kerja-kerja pembinaan akan berkuat kuasa hari ini dan di-

jangka siap dalam tempoh 16 bulan.

"Pada Julai lalu, Bina Puri diberi kontrak untuk menjalankan projek pembinaan kompleks berkenaan pada nilai RM388.7 juta. Tawaran projek terbaharu ini meningkatkan lagi nilai projek-projek baharu pada tahun ini iaitu kepada RM760 juta," katanya dalam kenyataan di sini hari ini.

Kompleks Pentadbiran Kerajaan Negeri Sabah yang baharu meliputi kawasan seluas enam hektar, berada di sepanjang pesisir pantai menghadap Laut China Selatan.

Kompleks itu terletak di kawasan sekitar mercu tanda utama Sabah, Bangunan Yayasan Sabah.

Tambah Hock Seng, kompleks kemudahan bersepadu itu meliputi menara pejabat 30 tingkat dan dua buah blok bangunan sembilan tingkat yang menjadikannya sebagai struktur bangunan paling tinggi di Sabah.

Menara pejabat tersebut turut menempatkan pejabat Ketua Menteri Sabah bersama-sama menteri-menteri kabinetnya.

"Pada waktu ini, perkembangan pembinaan kompleks tersebut adalah 76 peratus siap," ujarnya.

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## New project raises Bina Puri order book to RM2.01bil

**PETALING JAYA:** Construction firm Bina Puri Holdings Bhd has secured an RM64.99mil project in Sabah, bringing its total unbuilt order book to RM2.01bil.

In a filing with Bursa Malaysia, the company said its unit Bina Puri Sdn Bhd had accepted the letter of award from Jabatan Kerjaya Sabah to undertake additional works for the proposed new Sabah State

Administrative Complex in Teluk Likas, Sabah, under the Federal Government's facilitation fund.

The contract comprises upgrading works to an existing seawall, an external roundabout for proposed traffic diversion and fencing.

Construction will commence today and is expected to be completed in 16 months.

Including the latest award, the

group has secured RM760mil in new projects in 2014.

The new proposed Sabah State Administrative Complex is located in the vicinity of Sabah's most prominent landmark, the Sabah Foundation Building. The new Sabah State Administrative Complex covers 15 acres of land, sited along the shoreline overlooking the South China Sea.

The facility includes a 30-storey

office tower and two blocks of nine-storey buildings, making it one of the tallest structures in Sabah.

The tower, which is currently 76% complete, will also house the Sabah Chief Minister's office, together with his Cabinet Ministers.

Bina Puri was awarded the construction of the Sabah State Administrative Complex valued at RM388.7mil in July 2011.

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# Bina Puri bags RM64.99m job, brings order book to RM2b

KUALALUMPUR: Bina Puri Holdings Bhd has bagged additional upgrading works in Sabah worth RM64.99 million, bringing its unbuilt order book to RM2.01 billion. Of the total order book, new projects secured this year stood at RM760 million.

In a filing with Bursa Malaysia yesterday, Bina Puri said its wholly-owned subsidiary Bina Puri Sdn Bhd had accepted a letter of award from Jabatan Kerjaraya, Sabah, on Dec 15, to undertake additional works for the proposed new Sabah State Administrative Complex, Teluk Likas, Sabah (Phase 1 — Building Works) under the federal government's facilitation fund. The project, which commences construction today and has a completion period of 16 months, consists of

upgrading works to the existing seawall, upgrading works to an external roundabout for the proposed traffic diversion, and upgrading of fencing.

"With [these] additional works awarded, is crucial for us to complete the Sabah State Administrative Complex on time as it will be one of the new prominent landmarks of the state," Bina Puri group managing director Tan Sri Datuk Tee Hock Seng said in a statement.

Bina Puri said the works are not expected to have any material effect on its net assets and earnings for the financial year ending Dec 31, 2014.

The new proposed Sabah State Administrative Complex, which covers a 6ha piece of land located near the Sabah Foundation Building, features a 30-storey office tower and two blocks of nine-storey buildings.

Bina Puri said the construction of the tower — which will also house the Sabah chief minister's office together with his cabinet ministers' — is 76% completed. The group was awarded the construction of the Sabah State Administrative Complex, worth RM388.7 million, in July 2011.

Bina Puri shares closed up 0.94% at 53.5 sen yesterday, giving it a market capitalisation of RM95.18 million.

According to theedgemarkets.com, Bina Puri's valuation score stood at 1.8 on a scale of 0 to 3, with 3 suggesting a company gives higher-than-market-average returns and is trading at a lower-than-average valuation, while it has a fundamental score of 0.15, which measures its balance sheet strength and profitability. The stock has a volatility rate of 2 on a scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being the least volatile.
